13. Unless both you and the client agree **in writing** to **BINDING ARBITRATION**, this arbitration is **NON-BINDING**. This means either of you has the right to ask for a new trial in a civil court within 30 days from the date the award is mailed to you. If neither of you asks for a new trial in 30 days, the award automatically comes final and binding.

14. **May a client be compelled to arbitration?** A client **may not** be compelled to arbitrate any fee dispute with his or her attorney. In the event that any attorney requests arbitration of a fee dispute with his or her client, the arbitration committee shall obtain jurisdiction only if the client executes an agreement to arbitrate.
